description

The bouquet opens with a burst of ripe blueberries, the sweet essence of cherry reduction sauce, and a backdrop of toasted oak that recedes with time. Black plum emerges, intertwined with subtle notes of olive tapenade and a decadent layer of dark chocolate. Black cherry, black plum, and black currant flavors are interwoven with the surprise of crispy, savory bacon and coffee bean. While the flavors are bold, the tannins remain soft, caressing the palate rather than dominating it. The acids are juicy and luscious, leaving the mouth refreshed and yearning for another sip.
